***Re: Changes to Middle School Camp Program due to high temperatures***

Due to the forecasted high temperatures, we have decided to modify the Middle School camp program in order to keep our students safe and out of the midday heat.

Our Wednesday outdoor activity has now been changed to an exciting trip to the movies. The students will be seeing the movie Frozen 2 (this will certainly take our minds off the outdoor heat).

Thursday's program has also been amended as students will not be attending the Maze. Instead they will only be attending Outback Splash for a shortened period of time to enjoy the water activities. There are plenty of shaded areas at this venue and it will be compulsory for all students to wear a T-shirt, hat and sunscreen (all staff will be equipped with sunscreen to ensure all students are covered at all times). On Friday morning our students will now be attending the HBF indoor pool activity area. There are slides and an indoor water area that caters for our students. Please be aware that these changes will incur no extra costs.

In the evening we will have the use of portable air-conditioning units, extra fans and cool flannels. If parents are still concerned with their child staying over-night, further options can be arranged with their class teacher. Alternatively, if parents would prefer to withdraw their child from the camp altogether, a full refund will be provided.

We are working hard to provide these alternative options to ensure that all measures are taken to keep the students comfortable from the midday heat and extremely high temperatures.
