

SITE PREPARATION & NIGHT WORKS

Mid-February - March 2023

Preparing various sites along the rail corridor for construction.

What we are doing

- Relocating services, including drilling under the rail reserve.
- Ongoing locating of existing services (Water, gas, electricity, and telecommunications).
- Road remediation works post March public holiday long weekend.

When

- Monday-Sunday, 7am-7pm
- 10pm Friday 3 March – 5am Tuesday 7 March (continuous works)

Where

- Night works - George Street, Mallard Way, Wharf Street, Crawford Street, Sevenoaks Street and Railway Parade intersections.
- Various locations along the railway line including at level crossings and at stations.

What to expect

- For safety reasons, certain works need to take place after hours while trains are not running.
- Noise, vibration, and dust
- Traffic management will be in place to reduce congestion, parking impacts and safety concerns, with traffic controllers directing traffic flow.
- Bus routes will be disrupted during the road closures, including routes 201 and 907.
- All works will follow approved environmental and traffic management plans.

Temporary road closures (see maps overleaf)

- 27 February to 12 March
- Road closures on Railway Parade, Sevenoaks Street and Crawford Street.

About the project

The METRONET Victoria Park-Canning Level Crossing Removal project is Perth's first major elevated rail designed to improve public transport safety, create new and versatile public open space for the community and reduce traffic congestion.
